

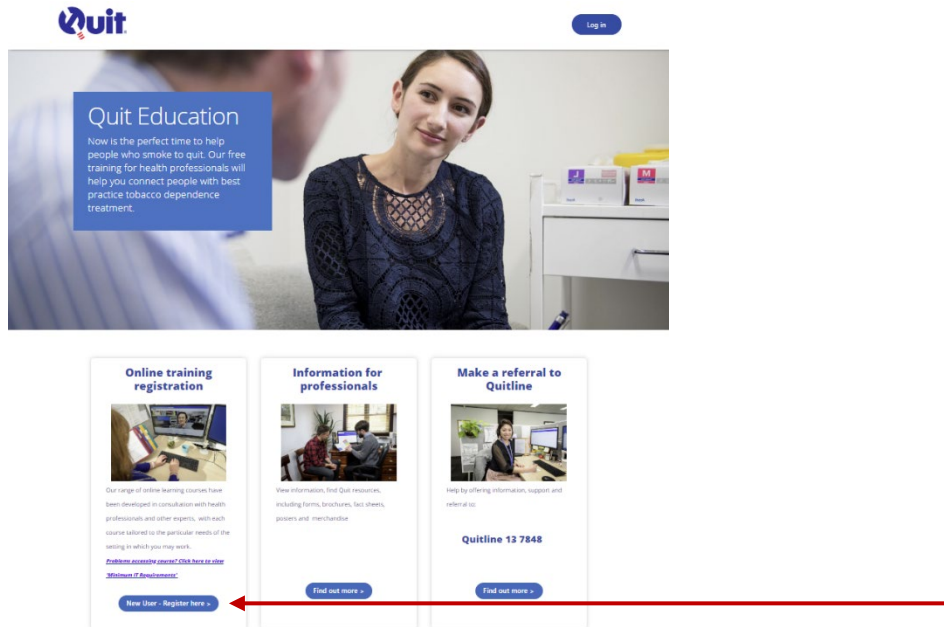
How do I register for the Hospital/Health Services course?

Step 1

Complete the online registration

- Registration for the Quit online training is available at: education.quit.org.au
- On the Quit Education page, scroll down and select **“New User - Register here”** button under the **“Online Training for health professionals”** block.

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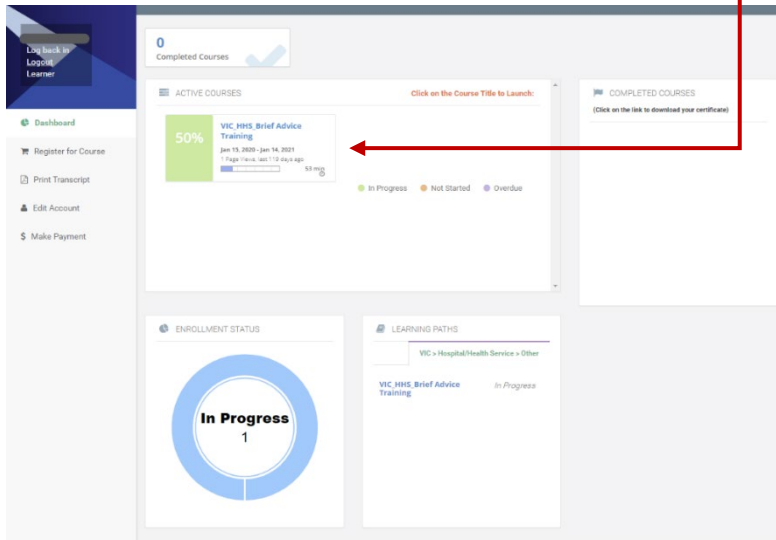

Brief Advice Training - Health Services

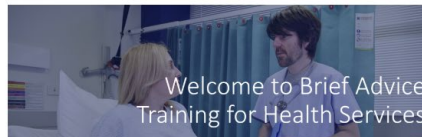
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INTRODUCTION



This free online training is for health professionals working in health service settings. It will equip you with the skills, confidence and knowledge to provide smoking cessation brief advice to patients.

Most people who smoke want to quit, but the majority do not use proven smoking cessation interventions. Smoking has a negative impact on many aspects of medical care, and an interaction with the hospital system is an ideal time to raise smoking with patients.

Brief advice is a simple, fast and effective way to promote cessation and to connect patients with best practice tobacco dependence treatment - a combination of multisection behavioural intervention through Outline and smoking cessation pharmacotherapy.

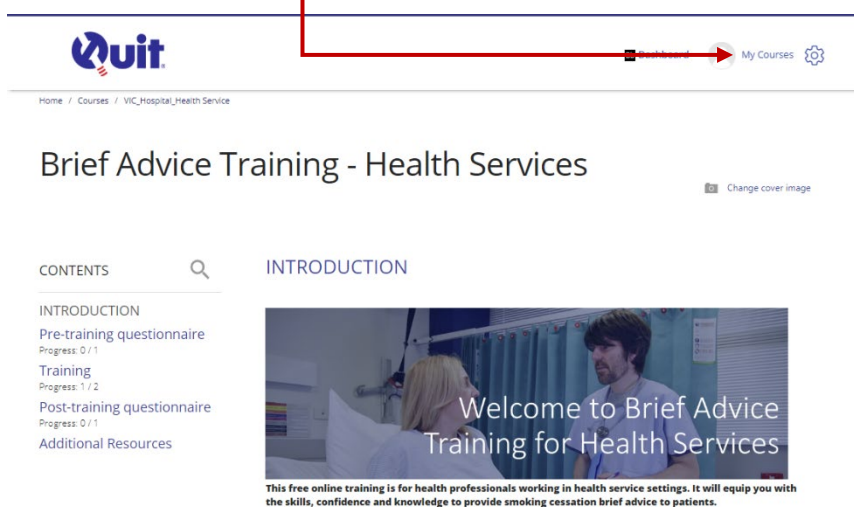
Select the play button to watch this brief video from Dr Rudi Gesser talking about the importance of providing smoking cessation brief advice to hospital patients.



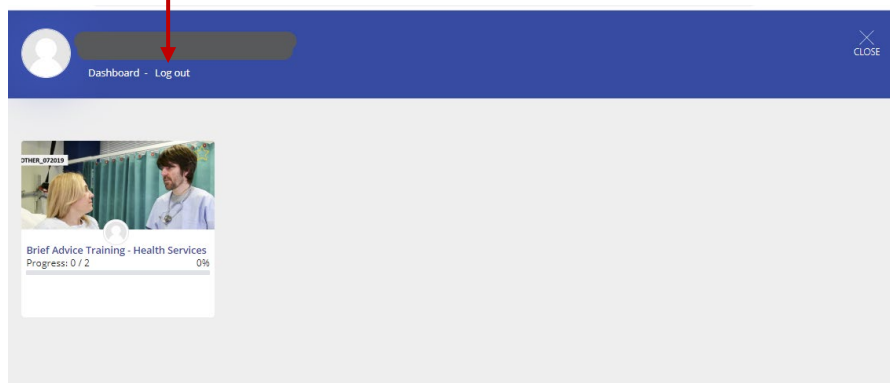
Step 4

- Select the “My Courses” link on the top right-hand corner of the page



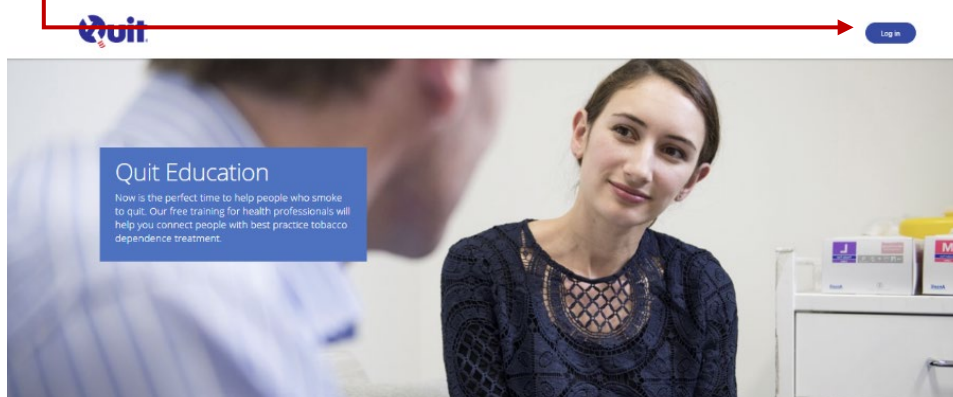
- Select the “Log out” link on the top left-hand side of the page



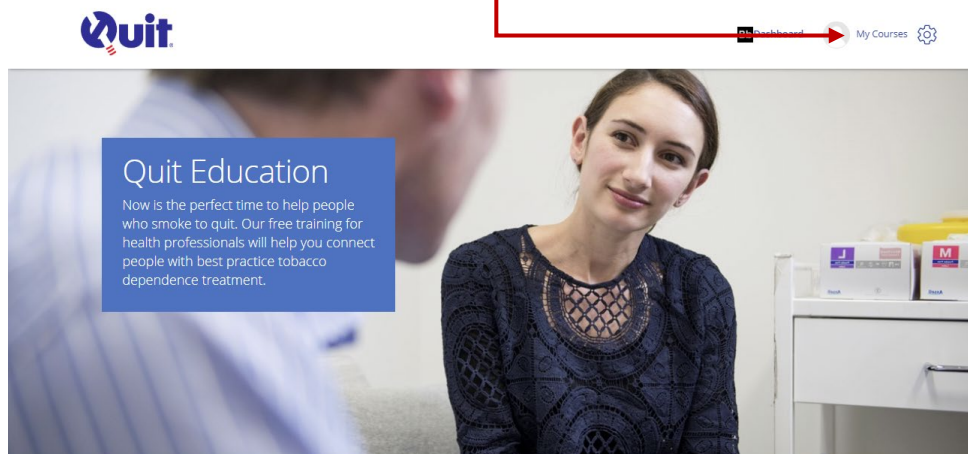
Step 5

If you exit the course and wish to log back in, to resume your training:

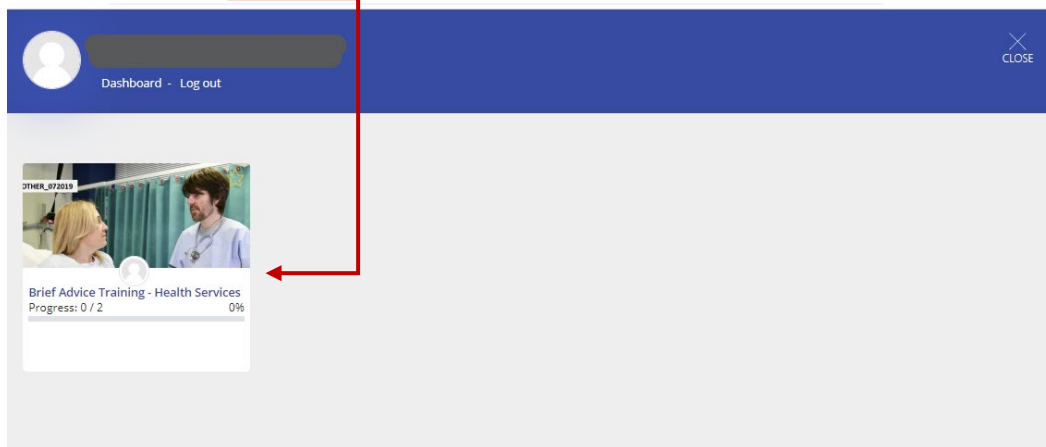
- Open your browser window (Chrome is preferred browser)
